All the activities will take place at the Department of Mathematics and Statistics of the Université de Montréal, Pavillon André-Aisenstadt, 2920, Chemin de la Tour and the Pavillon Claire-McNicoll located next to the Pavillon Aisenstadt. From Pierre-Elliott-Trudeau International Airport

By bus: Montréal-Trudeau Airport – Montreal downtown, The Express 747, 8\$ one way trip.

From Gare Centrale (arrival in Montreal by train)

- Public transport in Montreal
